NB: Although old methods exclude LPNs in their calculations, they are included throughout this work.

PERSONAL EXERCISE: Construct your own SDDL. Once your LGs and LCs are calculated and positioned, you are ready to begin figuring out how they can assist you to know the whats, whens, whys and hows of your life.

STEP 4: HOW TO CALCULATE AGE CYCLES FOR LIFE

Each LG/C pair governs 9-year periods, except for the first pair of LG/Cs. A special formula, provided below, is used to calculate the length of its duration. Pythagoras based this formula upon the "four cycles of man" which he found to have special significance. It simply translates to $4 \times 9 = 36$.

HOW TO CALCULATE THE 1st LG/C's AGE SPAN (using 24-9-1928)

- STEP 1:** Calculate the LPN ($2+4+9+1+9+2+8 = 35$) and reduce to a single digit $3+5 = 8$.
- STEP 2:** Subtract the single digit LPN8 from 36. ($36 - 8 = 28$)
- STEP 3:** The result is that the first LG and LC cycle rules from 0 - 28 years.
- STEP 4:** Once the age range of the 1st LG/C cycle is calculated, add 9 years to each remaining pair of LG/Cs. This determines the ages for all succeeding 9-year cycles that follow on from the first, long cycle as shown in the example below.
